Feast of the God Tou Tei

Given the popularity of the belief of Tou Tei (the God of Earth) in Macao, some temples in the city organise blessing ceremonies, lion dances and performances of Chinese opera for the Feast of the God Tou Tei on the second day of the second lunar month every year. The festivities at Tou Tei Temple (Patane), Foc Tac Temple (Rua da Praia do Manduco) and Fok Tak Chi Pagoda (Horta da Mitra) are most well-known. On the day of the Feast, people visit the Tou Tei Temple to offer sacrifices to pray for blessings like safety, health and a future without hurdles. These result in prosperous and flourishing scenes at the temples, and the Feast is one of the major festivals for the Chinese community in Macao.

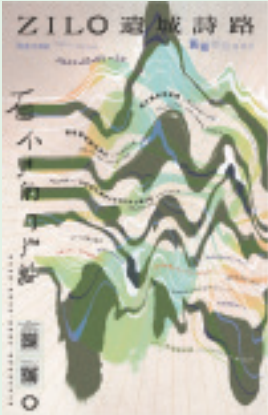

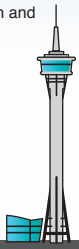
Macao Full of Fun - Smart Trip Planner Tourism Hotline

Qingmao Port is located 800 metres from the Border Gate Port. The departure hall to Guangdong is on the third floor of the facility, and the arrival hall inbound to Macao is on the second floor. For passenger clearance services, there are 50 automated channels inbound and 50 automated channels outbound, and additionally, two staffed counters in each direction. The border crossing facility implements a "Joint Inspection and One-Time Release" principle regarding customs clearance of people. With a daily capacity for handling 200,000 people, the checkpoint is now only available for eligible residents of Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macao. 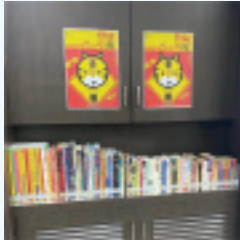

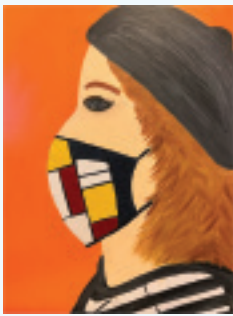
