Macao's distinctive religious "Na Tcha Belief and Customs" was inscribed on the National List of Intangible Cultural Heritage Representative Items in 2014. During the Feast of Na Tcha, which takes place on the 18th day of the fifth month of the lunar calendar, Na Tcha Temples at Calçada das Verdades and next to the Ruins of St. Paul's host various festive activities respectively, praying for the eradication of epidemics and disasters, good health, and harmony and prosperity citywide. Those interested in the city's religious customs and beliefs about Na Tcha, should participate in these activities in person to know more about these customs.

1st Anniversary Celebrations at Macao Grand Prix Museum

Providing visitors with Macao Grand Prix-related knowledge, entertainment, leisure and learning elements, the four-storey Macao Grand Prix Museum introduces the new feature of a 360-degree panoramic view for a virtual online tour. The zones, installations and exhibits in the Museum are brought to life in a three-dimensional, 360-degree panorama before the eyes of audiences by professional photography and software. Visitors can enjoy an online virtual tour at the official website of the Macao Grand Prix Museum: mgpm.macaotourism.gov.mo/vrtours.



On 1st June, the first anniversary of the opening of the Macao Grand Prix Museum, all visitors who visit the museum are welcome to take a photo with Macao Tourism Mascot MAK MAK and receive a souvenir upon completion of their assigned tasks. Smart Application for Visitor Flows

The website-based "Smart Application for Visitor Flows" offers computer-generated estimates for foot traffic at main tourist attractions around Macao, namely for the immediately-following four hours, the following 24 hours and the following seven days. Forecasts are presented according to different levels of congestion in relation to numbers of tourists, ranging from "comfortable", "moderate", or "lightly congested", to "congested" or "heavily congested". The goal of the app is to allow visitors and industry operators to better plan an exploration of Macao, and improve the overall experience of such a visit. The system currently monitors a total of 20 popular local tourist attractions, including a number of attractions in the UNESCO-listed Historic Centre of Macao, as well as sites in Taipa and Coloane.




