May there be FUN in Macao

During the early summer in May, Macao features an intriguing and trendy selection of 360-degree panoramic activities for visitors - for the first dip in the water this summer, visitors can opt for Studio City Water Park (1st to 31st May), the ocean-themed Children's Amusement Exhibition (1st to 31st May), and the exhilarating Macao International Dragon Boat Races 2022 (29th May & 3rd Jun).

Visitors can enjoy the kaleidoscope of the artworld at the 32nd Macao Arts Festival (1st May to 2nd Jun), followed by the annual religious occasions Tam Kong Festival (8th May) and Procession of Our Lady of Fatima (13th May). These activities offer ways for visitors to feel and understand the fusion of the Chinese and Western cultures in Macao.

The Light up Macao Drone Gala 2022 (1st to 8th May) is the highlight of the activities this month, when 880 drones weave together elements of festivals, events and unique architecture of Macao in the sky with the theme of "Macao for All Seasons", creating a new nightscape for the city.

Light up Macao Drone Gala 2022

Themed "Macao for All Seasons", this year's Drone Gala weaves together different elements such as festivals, events and unique architecture, presenting a total of eight drone shows taking place in four nights, namely Spring Rejoice, Fun-tastic Summer, Golden Fall Delights, and A Merry Winter. In every show, a constellation of 880 drones is choreographed to present more captivating patterns. Upon admission to the designated audience area set up for the Drone Gala, audiences are required to present their green Macao Health Code, scan the venue code, undergo temperature checks and maintain social distance, as well as to wear masks throughout the time on site.

New activities are unfolding in tandem with the Drone Gala, including the display of a gigantic drone and the distinctive patterns formed by drones, drone photography contest and drone formation design contest. Public can also log into the online game of "Light up Macao Drone Gala 2022" on or before 8th May, and earn points by answering questions or completing specific tasks, which can be redeemed for prizes or offers from various local merchants. Users who achieve a certain number of points are able to participate in a lucky draw, which is held on the four show days. Don't miss it!

Procession of Our Lady of Fatima

A traditional religious custom in Macao with a history of nearly 100 years, the Procession of Our Lady of Fatima is dedicated to the celebration of the apparitions witnessed by three shepherds of Our Lady of Fatima in Fatima, Portugal in 1917. It was added to the Intangible Cultural Heritage List in 2019. This year's Feast and Novena of Our Lady of Fatima is held in the St. Dominic's Church. The procession of the sculpture of Our Lady of Fatima will then make its way by vehicle to the Chapel of Our Lady of Penha, with a recitation of rosary and prayers, providing a solemn and impressive scene.

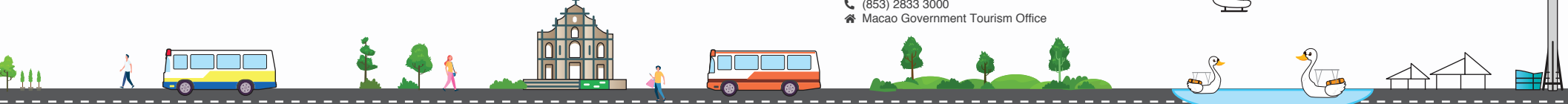

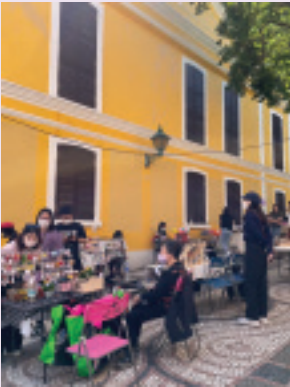

The website-based “Smart Application for Visitor Flows” offers computer-generated estimates for foot traffic at main tourist attractions around Macao, namely for the immediately-following four hours, the following 24 hours and the following seven days. Forecasts are presented according to different levels of congestion in relation to numbers of tourists, ranging from “comfortable”, “moderate”, or “lightly congested”, to “congested” or “heavily congested”. The goal of the app is to allow visitors and industry operators to better plan an exploration of Macao, and improve the overall experience of such a visit. The system currently monitors a total of 20 popular local tourist attractions, including a number of attractions in the UNESCO-listed Historic Centre of Macao, as well as sites in Taipa and Coloane.

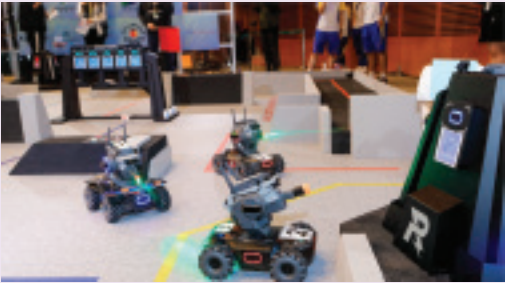
