On the night of the Moon Festival, visitors can attend and celebrate the Starry Night 2022 - Mid-Autumn Moon (10th Sep) held at the Macao Science Center. The autumn season is also the perfect time to enjoy outdoor activities. Macao has a lot of natural sites and facilities that visitors can include in their itineraries for a green excursion, including the Ecological Trail and Pond in Avenida da Praia, Taipa, the Wetlands in Seac Pai Van, the Ecological Trail Garden of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants and South China Medicinal Plants Garden, Happy Farm, Oscar Farm, Natural and Agrarian Museum, Pavilion of Animal Specimens in Macao and the Macao Giant Panda Pavilion. Let's also visit the Macao New Eight Scenic Spots with the fall flairs and indulge in the breathtaking views.

World Tourism Day is celebrated on 27th Sep when the exciting and traditional Tray Race takes place across the Historic Centre of Macao. For those who are interested in shopping for value deals, the 2022 Sands Shopping Carnival (10th to 12th Sep) and the 10th Macao International Travel (Industry) Expo (23rd to 25th Sep) are the places to be. This year's Expo brings in cutting-edge elements and abundant offerings to enrich spectators' experience. Besides an array of Cloud Series activities, the "Lusofonia Pavilion" will be set up in the Expo for the first time, boasting booths of delicacies, handicrafts and performances from Portuguese-speaking countries to underscore the city's integration of Chinese and Portuguese cultures and historical background. The Palace Museum also marks its debut in the Expo this year, inviting experts in the preservation of ancient architecture to showcase intangible cultural heritage skills onsite like colour painting of ancient architecture. The new "Macao as Destination for Wedding Ceremonies Pavilion" facilitates the development of wedding tourism. The organisers have also invited chefs at local Michelin-starred and Black Pearl award-winning restaurants to demonstrate their culinary skills while spectators can have a taste of the delicacies prepared by local distinctive food and beverage establishments in the "Gastronomy Pavilion". The "Macao Culture and Creation Pavilion" and "MAK MAK Pavilion" feature local cultural creative products. Spectators with spending of MOP300 or above (up to a maximum of three receipts during the 3-day Expo period) on any products in the Expo are entitled to enter the "MAK MAK Pavilion" Lucky Draw once. For those who make online registration for the Expo, they can redeem a MOP10 consumption certificate by showing the registration QR code to the staff, and the consumption certificate can be counted as part of the spending amount for an entry to the "MAK MAK Pavilion" Lucky Draw.

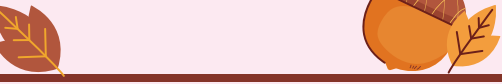


Autumn Adventures

Ecological Trail and Ecological Pond in Avenida da Praia of Taipa



Alongside Avenida da Praia, Taipa, there is a beautiful wetland area which attracts many herons, forest birds, dragonflies, butterflies and other animals. It is one of the important ecological areas in Macao. Ecological trails and bird-watching houses are set up in the area for nature lovers to watch birds without disturbing their habitats. Apart from the ecological trail, visitors can also visit the ecological pond in the wetlands during opening hours. To make it convenient for the public to learn about its biodiversity, explanation boards with information about organisms in the wetlands have been installed in the area to provide basic information about birds, insects, aquatic plants, among others. While strolling along the trail to enjoy the beautiful scenery, visitors can also visit the Portuguese-style buildings Taipa Houses, which are acclaimed as one of the top eight sites of Macao.

Wetlands in Seac Pai Van



Located on the northeast corner of Seac Pai Van Park, the area was transformed into wetlands through the improvement of the water bodies, planning of the visiting route and installation of facilities such as recreational platforms and pavilions, attracting different kinds of animals and insects. On a crisp autumn day, why not go out into nature and get both your body and mind relaxed?

Star Merchant Award

The “Quality Tourism Services Accreditation Scheme” (QTSAS) Awards, presented by the Macao Government Tourism Office, includes two accolades namely the “Star Merchant Award” and “Service Star Award”. 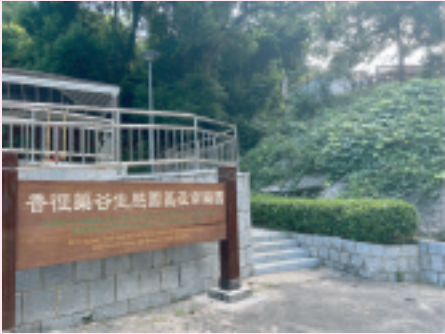


Ecological Trail Garden of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants and South China Medicinal Plants Garden

The Ecological Trail Garden of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants and South China Medicinal Plants Garden have a total area of approximately 30,000 square metres, and the medicinal plants inside are grouped into eight display areas, each of which is dedicated to a specific habitat and ecosystem, such as wetlands, rocky ground, hilly landscapes and bamboo groves. The gardens are home to over 300 species of medicinal plants, covering native species such as Ivy Trees (*Schefflera heptaphylla*), Chinese Chrysanthemum (*Chrysanthemum indicum*), Hairy Figs (*Ficus hirta*), Sweet Osmanthus (*Osmanthus fragrans*) and Hilo Holly (*Ardisia crenata*), as well as unique species introduced from Guangxi Botanical Garden of Medicinal Plants, like Fiveleaf Gynostemma (*Gynostemma pentaphyllum*) and Hairyvein Agrimonia (*Agrimonia pilosa*). The broad variety of medicinal plants have been introduced to provide food and shelter for native animals and insects.

The topography of the garden is undulating, and visitors to the garden can stroll along the shade of the trees while appreciating the different forms of plants and learn more about their medicinal properties. It is an important area for the protection of Macao’s natural ecosystems and conservation of its fluvial ecosystems.

Happy Farm

Located in Coloane, the Happy Farm is an urban oasis with multiple functions. The farm is mainly divided into a nursery area and a farming area. The nursery area is planted with various plants and saplings, while the farming area includes a natural water conservation area, flower field area, fruit area, vegetable area, herb area and planting experience area. The farm also holds various educational workshops from time to time to enable the public to learn green ecological science and experience the fun of farming.

Oscar Farm

Oscar Farm takes up an area of about 7,000 square metres and provides a variety of facilities, including a big tent for events, animal barns, composting and biochar production zone, and crop display area. It is a good place for the public to learn about agriculture-related plants and animals.

Smart Application for Visitor Flows

The website-based “Smart Application for Visitor Flows” offers computer-generated estimates for foot traffic at main tourist attractions around Macao, namely for the immediately-following four hours, the following 24 hours and the following seven days. Forecasts are presented according to different levels of congestion in relation to numbers of tourists, ranging from “comfortable”, “moderate”, or “lightly congested”, to “congested” or “heavily congested”. The goal of the app is to allow visitors and industry operators to better plan an exploration of Macao, and improve the overall experience of such a visit. The system currently monitors a total of 20 popular local tourist attractions, including a number of attractions in the UNESCO-listed Historic Centre of Macao, as well as sites in Taipa and Coloane.

Natural and Agrarian Museum



With natural resources and ecological conservation as its theme, the Natural and Agrarian Museum is the first museum of nature in Coloane dedicated to showcases of natural resources. The two-house museum features five exhibition areas, which introduce Macao’s natural geography, animal and plant specimens and simulated mangroves, in order to allow visitors to experience the diversity of Macao’s natural ecology.

Pavilion of Animal Specimens in Macao

Being the first exhibition pavilion to showcase the animals and natural ecology in Macao, the Pavilion of Animal Specimens in Macao features a total of eight themed exhibition rooms, a screening room and a specimen production room. The majority of the animal specimens displayed in the pavilion are wild animals once found locally, including pangolin that can no longer be seen in Macao, the Macao nanhaiopotamon crab, and the Asiatic Black Bear BOBO. It is a good place for families to enjoy and learn together, exploring the historical changes of Macao’s natural ecology.

Macao Giant Panda Pavilion



Visitors are welcome to go to the Macao Giant Panda Pavilion to visit Kai Kai and Xin Xin, two giant pandas given to Macao by the Central People’s Government, and Jian Jian and Kang Kang, twin giant pandas born in Macao in June 2016. And don’t forget to choose some gifts and souvenirs featuring giant pandas at the gift shop. To get a better understanding of giant pandas, visitors must not miss the Macao Giant Panda Information Centre which hosts exhibitions and guided tours on a regular basis, providing easier access for visitors to nature and allowing them to gain a better understanding of these “national treasures”.

Hac Sá Temporary Green and Leisure Area

The Hac Sá Temporary Green and Leisure Area includes an off-roading track, wooden playground, plant area, and an avenue with a tree landscape. It is a great place for families to spend pleasant moments on the lawn on sunny days. Covering an area of about 2,700 square metres, the off-roading track in Hac Sá with a total length of 180 metres, adopts an environmental-friendly design and is paved with natural sand and pebbles. The track features a young children’s zone, where quadricycles are available for rent on site, and a youth zone, where users have to bring their own trek bicycles and safety gear. The facilities in the wooden playground, retaining the organic form of wood, are made from recycled trees. The photogenic plant area is composed of different zones, including zones of bamboo, miscanthus, celandine and marsh plants. Taking a stroll in the area, visitors can experience the green vibes.

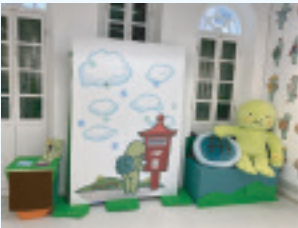

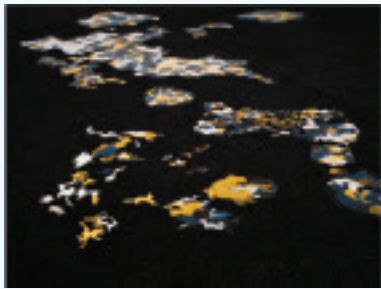
