Zhou Yi, the Chinese master of fondant art known as the “King of Sugar” in China, held his first solo exhibition of fondant art in Macao. The exhibition features five life-sized fondant art sculptures that are all over two metres tall and are created exclusively for Macao. All the artworks innovatively combine food-making techniques, such as dough-sculpting and fondant art, and artistic techniques such as painting, spray painting and sculpting, which present “auspiciousness” and “courtesy” that are treasured in Chinese traditional culture. A mini theatre guided tour, “The Tale of Glorious Moments”, is also presented to take the exhibition experience to a new level. With a connection between theatre art and fondant art, the cross-disciplinary theatre is performed by local actors and is based on the true account of a Cantonese poet who travelled to Macao in the late Qing Dynasty.

If you are looking for an immersive experience in Chinese art, head to the Spectacle and see “WATERCOLOR STORY”, a dynamic Chinese digital art piece that showcases three themed acts in bold traditional Chinese ink colours. The captivating display is presented on 25 large LED screens, delivering a breathtaking visual experience to viewers.

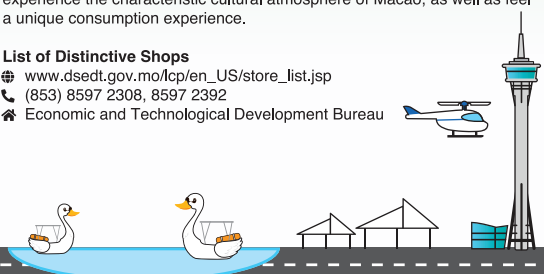

Commemorative Gallery of the Macao Basic Law

The “Basic Law of Macao” is the fundamental law of Macao, which also embodies the principle of “one country, two systems” and the basic policy of the Central Government towards Macao. The “Basic Law of Macao” was officially promulgated on 31st March 1993 and is celebrating its 30th anniversary this year. The Commemorative Gallery of the Macao Basic Law at NAPE features multiple exhibition areas that showcase the historical background, drafting process, promotion and implementation of the Macao Basic Law, and provides audio guides and public guided tours. Visitors can gain an in-depth understanding of the important significance of the “Basic Law of Macao”.



The interactive education area also features “Traces of Bygone Days - Exhibition of Nostalgic Items”. It displays exhibits related to the gold jewellery industry, such as plaques, scales, gold striking tools, jewellery boxes and receipts. This exhibit offers a glimpse into the history and development of the gold jewellery industry in Macao following the handover.

Popular Science Zone of the Wetlands and Ecological Trail in Avenida da Praia

In addition to the ecological trail, visitors can also visit the nearby “Popular Science Zone of the Wetlands in Avenida da Praia”, which features explanatory facilities to introduce insect and demonstrate the concept of ecological integration, as well as an outdoor exhibition on the theme of the Wetlands to presents its ecosystem, flora and fauna and history. Additionally, the zone also features interactive installations and themed displays, making it a fun and educational destination for families to explore the rich biodiversity together.

Smart Application for Visitor Flows

The website-based “Smart Application for Visitor Flows” offers computer-generated estimates for foot traffic at main tourist attractions around Macao, namely for the immediately-following four hours, the following 24 hours and the following seven days. Forecasts are presented according to different levels of congestion in relation to numbers of tourists, ranging from “comfortable”, “moderate”, or “lightly congested”, to “congested” or “heavily congested”. The goal of the app is to allow visitors and industry operators to better plan an exploration of Macao, and improve the overall experience of such a visit. The system currently monitors over 100 popular local tourist attractions, including a number of attractions in the UNESCO-listed Historic Centre of Macao, as well as sites in Taipa and Coloane.

Guia Hill Pedestrian Tunnel and Walking System & the Guia Fortress



The Guia Hill Pedestrian Tunnel and Walking System, running north-south beneath Guia Hill and connecting ZAPE and Avenida de Horta e Costa, is about 400 metres long, which greatly facilitates the travel of the surrounding residents. The pedestrian tunnel is equipped with an automatic walking system and a vertical elevator that connects visitors to Guia Hill Fitness Trail. Visitors can also climb to the top of Guia Hill - the highest point of Macao Peninsula, to enjoy a panoramic view of the entire peninsula. They can also visit the Guia Fortress - one of Macao’s UNESCO World Heritage Sites, Guia Chapel, and Guia Lighthouse - the earliest modern lighthouse on the Chinese coast to experience Macao’s historical and cultural values where the East meets the West.

Former lec Long Firecracker Factory Walkway



In the last century, the firecracker industry was one of the three main handicraft industries in Macao, and Taipa was the main production base for firecrackers. Located in Taipa for almost a century, the former lec Long Firecracker Factory is the largest and most iconic former firecracker factory preserved in the city. Open to the public lately, the 400-metre-long walkway inside the former lec Long factory allows visitors to take a look at the fuse gluing zones, waterways, ponds, firecracker crimping zones and storehouses of the factory from the time when it was operational. Visitors can also watch videos to learn more about the production and manufacturing process of firecrackers through a tour guide system.

The walkway has been opened together with “The Echo of Firecrackers - Exhibition of the History of Macao Firecracker Industry”. Through the exhibitions’ collections, photos, and multimedia guided tours, visitors can interact with the exhibits and learn about the history of the lec Long Firecracker Factory, and details of the past of Macao’s firecracker industry. At the souvenir shop, a variety of exquisite products designed with elements of the factory are available for purchase. In addition, a “Tea Coaster Exhibition” at the entrance plaza of the Firecracker Factory until 5th March. It displays tea utensils and tea set arrangements and other aspects of traditional Chinese tea culture, providing visitors with an opportunity to learn about this cultural heritage. All are welcome!

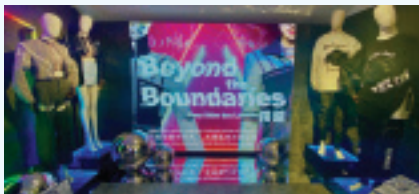
