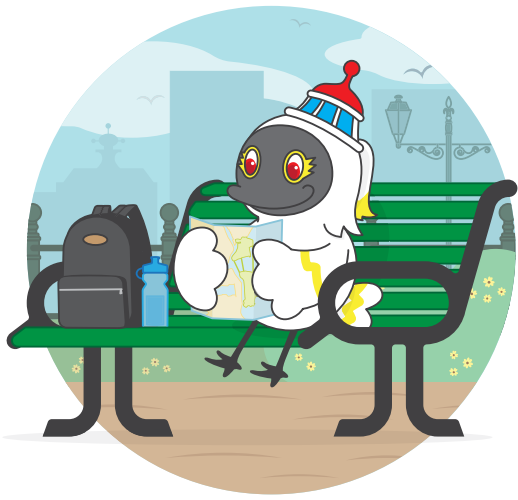

## FEAST ON MACAO'S SPRING OFFERINGS

The city is buzzing in April with a variety of exciting events

As April unfolds, a significant event awaits: the 4<sup>th</sup> Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area Chinese Theatre Cultural Festival (Apr 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>) presents audiences a range of cultural dramatic performances originating from places across China. Later in the month, the 12<sup>th</sup> Macao International Travel (Industry) Expo (MITE) (Apr 26<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>), organised by the Macao Government Tourism Office, will showcase the latest tourism-sector trends regionally and internationally, as well as offering holiday ideas and package deals for consumers.

Visitors can experience the rich traditional Chinese culture, Macao-style, through the annual Feast of Pak Tai (Apr 10<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>). Additionally, the ITTF Men's and Women's World Cup Macao 2024 presented by Galaxy Entertainment Group (Apr 15<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>) features some of the best international table tennis players from across the globe competing in Macao. Musical offerings this month include two performances by the Macao Orchestra: Melco Resorts & Entertainment presents "Violin Prodigy Christian Li" (Apr 13<sup>th</sup>),

featuring the rising violin star; and "Tribute to Rachmaninoff" (Apr 27<sup>th</sup>), with Hungarian conductor Gábor Káli and French pianist Marie-Ange Nguci. As a "City of Performing Arts", Macao offers a dazzling array of concerts for fans of many genres, ranging from the Chinese popular music of Aaron Kwok AMAZING DREAM Live in Macau 2024 (Apr 1<sup>st</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>) and LOUIS CHEUNG Live in Macau 2024 (Apr 13<sup>th</sup>) to Korean bands LUCY 1<sup>st</sup> WORLD TOUR written by FLOWER in MACAU (Apr 6<sup>th</sup>) and 2024 CNBLUE Live 'CNBLUENTITY' In Macau (Apr 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>).

The 12<sup>th</sup> Macao International Travel (Industry) Expo (MITE) is an event targeting sector professionals and the general public, providing the latter with an opportunity to learn about tourism destinations worldwide and initiate plans for their upcoming holiday breaks. MITE, which this year also marks the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the establishment of the Macao Special Administrative Region, aims to serve as a platform for exhibitors from different countries and regions to convene in Macao. The 2024 edition of MITE targets to captivate visitors via its exciting lineup of attractions. Highlights include: the debut of the "Belt and Road Initiative Pavilion"; the "Gastronomy Pavilion"; and the "The Cellar" zone. Additionally, the "Macao Street" will feature discounts on products exhibited there. There will also be a "Tourism + Education Pavilion" and a "1+4 Pavilion", as well as a number of online-based key opinion leaders (KOLs) live-streaming directly from the exhibition floor. Overall, the event's offerings allow industry professionals to 'travel' virtually around the world without leaving the expo. Various activities and collaboration opportunities are offered as part of MITE, leveraging the concept of "one exhibition in two places", connecting Macao and Hengqin.

The former fishing community in Taipa revered the Taoist god of the north, Pak Tai, and dedicated a temple to the deity over a century ago, with the structure still standing today. The day celebrated as Pak Tai's birthday – falling on the third day of the third month of the Chinese lunar calendar (this year on Apr 11<sup>th</sup>) – includes a noontime ceremony, followed by a lion dance and dragon dance parade, as well as Cantonese Opera performances on four consecutive nights.

Saltwater songs have long been a popular form of entertainment in Macao's fishing communities, capturing the essence of the local fishermen's daily lives. Sung in Cantonese without musical accompaniment, these tunes have since 2020 been classified as part of Macao's Intangible Cultural Heritage. The theatrical production “Ballad on Water” merges the art of theatre with saltwater songs, narrating encounters of a man and a woman within a fishing community and offering a glimpse into their daily existence as a couple aboard a fishing boat. Following each performance, audiences are invited to sing along to simple saltwater songs, guided by an expert.

## USEFUL INFORMATION

### Promoting a ‘green’ Macao

Since the beginning of this year, the importation of non-biodegradable, single-use plastic plates and glasses, as well as disposable polystyrene-foam trays for food items, has been prohibited. This supplements bans on the importation of disposable polystyrene-foam tableware (including food boxes, bowls, cups, and plates), as well as of non-biodegradable, single-use plastic cutlery, straws, and drink stirrers. Also, as a measure to reduce waste and protect the environment, shoppers requiring a plastic bag for their purchases are subject to a surcharge of MOP1.

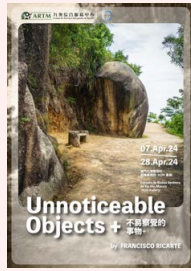

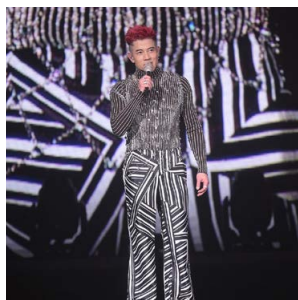
