Promoting a 'green' Macao

Since the beginning of this year, the importation of non-biodegradable, single-use plastic plates and glasses, as well as disposable polystyrene-foam travs for food items, has been prohibited. This supplements bans on the importation of disposable polystyrene-foam tableware (including food boxes, bowls, cups, and plates), as well as of non-biodegradable, single-use plastic cutlery, straws, and drink stirrers.
