As Macao basks in warmer temperatures, the city invites visitors to immerse themselves in some cool arts and culture. The 34th Macao Arts Festival (May 3rd - Jun 7th) promises audiences 'Wondrous Encounters', via captivating local and international programming. May also comes alive with Chinese folk festivals, including the Feast

May 1st and 15th are public holidays

of the Drunken Dragon (May 15th), A-Ma Festival (May 1st-3rd) and Tam Kong Festival (May 14th-18th). The Procession of Our Lady of Fátima (May 13th), a Catholic religious celebration with its roots in Portugal, symbolises the East-West cultural fusion found throughout Macao.

In the sporting realm, there is the

highly-anticipated return of the Macao round of the FIVB Women's Volleyball Nations League (May 28th -Jun 2nd). Other hot draws for May include pop concerts such as Melco Style's Residency Concert Series: Leon Lai STAGE ON 8 2024 (May 1st, 4th, 11th-12th and 18th-19th) and WU BAI AND CHINA BLUE ROCK STAR 2024 World Tour in Macau (May 11th-12th).

34th Macao **Arts Festival**

The 34th Macao Arts Festival features 19 programmes under the theme 'Wondrous Encounters'. On offer this year are theatre, Chinese opera, dance, circus, and music performances, as well as visual arts. There are also 23 outreach activities over 25 sessions. including meet-the-artist events, backstage tours, talks, workshops, and screenings of film versions of international stage performances.

MAY 13TH Procession of Our Lady of Fátima

The Procession of Our Lady of Fátima is a Catholic commemoration of the apparitions of the Virgin Mary in Fátima, Portugal, reported in 1917. The first Macao procession was 12 years later, in 1929. The event, held annually on May 13th, is now



part of the city's List of Intangible Cultural Heritage. The procession starts from St. Dominic's Church and journeys to Our Lady of Penha Chapel set on a hill overlooking Macao peninsula. The procession features two young girls and a boy in Portuguese traditional costume, representing the three sheeptending children who reported witnessing the appearances of the Virgin Mary in Fátima.

MAY 14TH-18TH **Tam Kong Festival**

The sea deity Tam Kong is revered in Taoism, particularly among fishermen in southern China, including Macao. Tam Kong Temple in Coloane is the sole local site specially dedicated to such veneration. The annual Tam Kong Festival - included in Macao's official Inventory of



Intangible Cultural Heritage - is observed on the eighth day of the Chinese lunar calendar's fourth month (this year on May 15th). A temporary stage made of bamboo is commonly erected to Cantonese opera performances. The festivities also feature a parade and a beer carnival.

Feast of the Drunken Dragon



The Feast of the Drunken Dragon is a unique folk festival celebrated by Macao's fishing-sector workers. The event is on China's National List of Intangible Cultural Heritage Representative Items, and is part of Macao's List of Intangible Cultural Heritage. It takes place annually on the eighth day of the Chinese lunar calendar's fourth month (this year on May 15th). Centrepiece of the celebrations is the Drunken Dragon and Lion Dance Parade, commencing at Senado Square, following a blessing ceremony. It then proceeds through several locations, including the Inner Harbour Ferry Terminal, the Red Market, Iao Hon Market, and A-Ma Temple. The Drunken Dragon dance is traditionally performed by men who dance while simultaneously spraying rice wine from their mouths and carrying effigies of dragons carved head to tail from wood. Another highlight of the festival is the distribution of "longevity rice", symbolising good fortune and health. For more information, please contact the organiser.

The Macao leg rejoins the tournament's calendar after a four-year hiatus. The national teams of China, the Dominican Republic, Italy, the Netherlands, Brazil, Thailand, Japan, and France make up the Macao pool, striving to be among the teams that make it to the finals in Bangkok, Thailand.

Promoting a 'Green' Macao

Since the beginning of this year, the importation of non-biodegradable, single-use plastic plates and glasses, as well as disposable polystyrene-foam travs for food items, has been prohibited. This supplements bans on the importation of disposable polystyrene-foam tableware (including food boxes, bowls, cups, and plates), as well as of non-biodegradable, single-use plastic cutlery, straws, and drink stirrers. Also, as a measure to reduce waste and protect the environment, shoppers requiring a plastic bag for their purchases are subject to a surcharge of MOP1


