# **USEFUL INFORMATION**

## Promoting a "Green" Macao Since the beginning of this year, the importation of

non-biodegradable, single-use plastic plates and cups, as well as disposable polystyrene-foam trays for food items, has been prohibited. This supplements bans on the importation of disposable polystyrene-foam tableware (including food boxes, bowls, cups, and plates), as well as of non-biodegrad able, single-use plastic cutlery, straws, and drink stirrers. Also, as a measure to reduce waste and protect the environment, shoppers requiring a plastic bag for their purchases are subject to a surcharge of MOP1.
