City shines bright, as fireworks light up the night sky

With everything from community culture to thrilling competitive events, Macao is set to dazzle visitors throughout September. A key date in the diary is the **Mid-Autumn Festival** (Sep 17th). Locals and visitors alike will be out and about with lanterns of all shapes and sizes, sharing a bit of moon-gazing in family groups, and enjoying a slice of mooncake.

Starting this month, the **Celebration of the 75th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China**, and the **25th anniversary of the establishment of the Macao Special Administrative Region 32nd Macao International Fireworks Display Contest**

(Sep 7th, 14th, 21st, Oct 1st and 6th) features teams from an array of countries, energising the night sky with a mesmerising display of colour and light. The seasonal fun includes the **2024 World Tourism Day Tray Race** (Sep 27th), as participants race downhill through the Historic Centre of Macao balancing serving trays. September sees a wave of mainstream sporting excitement across Macao. Table tennis enthusiasts get a treat via world-class matchups during the **WTT Champions Macao 2024 presented by Galaxy Entertainment Group** (Sep 9th-15th). Simultaneously, the **SJM 10th Asian Wushu Championships**

(Sep 12th-15th) will showcase the prowess of athletes specialising in this Chinese martial art. As a "City of Performing Arts", Macao offers a month filled with music. The **German Brass 50 Anniversary China Tour Macao** (Sep 8th) offers brass fans refined musical arrangements. Concertgoers can enjoy some K-pop excitement, with the **2024 aespa LIVE TOUR - SYNK: Parallel Line** (Sep 21st and 22nd). Whether you're a fan of high-energy music, soaring fireworks, sport or performing arts, Macao's September offerings promise memorable moments for all.

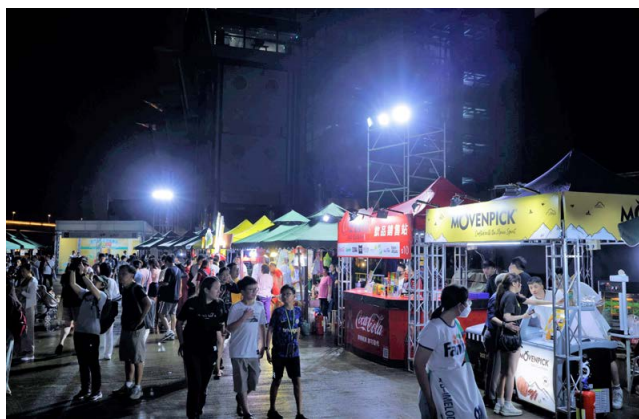


Ten teams from around the world are taking part in the 32nd Macao International Fireworks Display Contest, from this month into October. Each spectacle is launched via the waterfront by Macau Tower and has a musical accompaniment, for a multisensory experience. Spectators can watch from the waterside there or from several other prime viewing points. They include: Anim'Arte NAM VAN by the lakeside at Nam Van; the area of the Avenida de Sagres next to the Mandarin Oriental, Macau; Kun lam Ecumenical Centre; the Leisure Area of Kun lam Statue Waterfront; the Macao Science Center; and the shoreline in Taipa. Adding to the festive atmosphere, a Fireworks Carnival will be held next to the Macao Science Center on each display night. The carnival will feature a variety of food delicacies, music, dance performances, and games, promising fun for visitors all ages. This year's fireworks festival is special as it celebrates the 75th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China and the 25th anniversary of the establishment of the Macao Special Administrative Region.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Promoting a "Green" Macao

Since the beginning of this year, the importation of non-biodegradable, single-use plastic plates and cups, as well as disposable polystyrene-foam trays for food items, has been prohibited. This supplements bans on the importation of disposable polystyrene-foam tableware (including food boxes, bowls, cups, and plates), as well as of non-biodegradable, single-use plastic cutlery, straws, and drink stirrers. Also, as a measure to reduce waste and protect the environment, shoppers requiring a plastic bag for their purchases are subject to a surcharge of MOP1.

Visiting During Typhoon Season

The period from May to November is typhoon season in Macao. The city has five levels of tropical cyclone warning. They range from 1 (the lowest and least intense) through to 3, 8, 9 and 10 (the highest and most dangerous). When a cyclone signal of 8 or above is issued, public buses (including the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge shuttle bus service) and the light rail transit system are suspended. Macao's revised legal framework on alcoholic beverages stipulates that these products must not be sold or supplied to underage individuals at public venues. Those found providing alcoholic beverages to minors at public venues, even for non-commercial reasons, are liable to a maximum fine of MOP20,000.

Notice on Smoking

Individuals are prohibited from bringing vaping products (or e-cigarettes) into Macao; offenders are liable to a fine of MOP4,000. Macao's legal framework on smoking also prohibits all forms of smoking (including vaping) in indoor public places, except for designated smoking rooms in airports and casinos. All forms of smoking are prohibited within 10 metres of bus stops and taxi stands. Anyone smoking in non-smoking areas is liable to a fine of MOP1,500.
