The **Temporary Pedestrian Zone in Taipa Village during Chinese New Year** (until Feb 4th) will offer a safe and comfortable atmosphere for visitors to explore the area during the festive period.

As the celebrations unfold, make sure to catch the final moments of the three-month-long **Light up Macao 2024** (until Feb 28th), a citywide festival of stunning illuminations.

February is also a month for romance, with the Macao Orchestra's Saint Valentine's Day tribute, **Sands China Performing Arts Program Presents "Concert of Love in Seoul"** (Feb 15th). For fans of K-pop, the **2024-25 2NE1 ASIA TOUR [WELCOME BACK] IN MACAO** (Feb 22nd-23rd) promises high-energy contemporary sounds at their best. Embrace the Year of the Snake vibes and make February in Macao a month to remember!

Parade for Celebration of the Year of the Snake

Macao's annual marking of the Lunar New Year again promises to dazzle, bringing an explosion of **colour and music**, as well as **vibrant performances**, to the city's streets. Following the first round of this year's **parade** on January 31st – taking in the southern portion of Macao Peninsula – the second round weaves through the city's northern district, spreading



festive cheer and excitement. After each round, the Lunar New Year float vehicles will be put on static public display, offering an opportunity to capture stunning photographs.

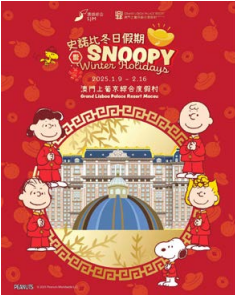

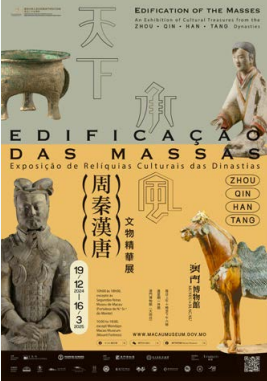

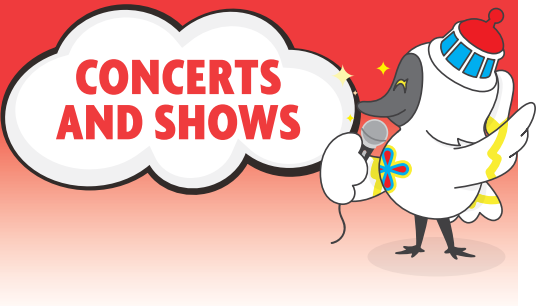
