The Procession of Saint Roque is an annual **Catholic act of homage**, included in the city's **Inventory of Intangible Cultural Heritage**. The procession takes place on the second Sunday of July every year, in honour of **Saint Roque**, for his intercession with the divinity to suppress a plague outbreak in Macao at the end of the 19th century. It starts from **St. Lazarus Church**, passes through the neighbouring streets, before heading back to the church.

The Feast of Kuan Tai, or the **Kuan Tai Celebrations**, is an annual event on the 24th day of the sixth month of the Chinese lunar calendar, which falls on July 18th this year. Visiting During Typhoon Season

The period from May to November is typhoon season in Macao. The city has five levels of tropical cyclone warning. They are 1 (the lowest and least intense), 3, 8, 9 and 10 (the highest and most dangerous). When a cyclone signal of 8 or above is issued, public buses (including the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge shuttle bus service) and the light rapid transit system are suspended.
