January in Macao means celebration, creativity, and cool entertainment! The **18th Macau New Year's Concert 2026** (Jan 3rd), presented by the Macao Youth Symphony Orchestra, sets the festive tone, showcasing talent and a spirit of renewal. It's also the final days of the light-installation extravaganza **LIGHT UP MACAO 2025** (until Jan 11th).

New year means fresh sporting spectacles. That includes the **21st Beijing Basketball Game for Chinese of the World Macao, China** (Jan 15th-20th), offering skill and a spirit of goodwill.

Macao's multicultural character is also front and centre this month. **The Sinulog Macau Festival 2026** (Jan 18th) celebrates Filipino culture, reflecting the city's status as a cultural exchange hub.

For music lovers, high-profile performances include **Terry Lin ONEtake 2.0 World Tour in MACAO** (Jan 10th) and **SUPER JUNIOR 20th Anniversary TOUR <SUPER SHOW 10> in MACAU** (Jan 9th-11th). The Macao Orchestra celebrates timeless genius with its **"Tribute to Mozart" Series** (Jan 23rd-25th), for the 270th anniversary of the birth of the Austrian composer.



UNTIL JAN 8TH Annual Exhibition of Macao Visual Arts – Chinese Painting and Calligraphy Category

The **Annual Exhibition of Macao Visual Arts** – organised by the Cultural Affairs Bureau – is a **cornerstone event** for the city's own creative community. It started as the Macao Annual Arts Exhibition, which underwent a revamp in 2013. The exhibition is nowadays divided into two categories: "Chinese Painting and Calligraphy" and "Western Media", and these are displayed in alternate years. This time, it's the Chinese forms, with submissions from **161 artists**. A total of **61 works** was selected for display, in formats including **Chinese-style painting**, **calligraphy**, **seal carving**, and **experimental ink art**.

"Above the Abyss" – Zhang Lanpo Solo Exhibition | On the Occasion of the Celebration of the 26th Anniversary of Macau Handover to China

Prominent visual artist **Zhang Lanpo** from Mainland China presents 18 works in this solo exhibition, spanning **photography** and **painting**. 
