The arrival in Macao of the Year of the Horse promises colour, joy, and high-spirited celebrations



Macao is welcoming the Lunar New Year at full sprint, with a programme of events to delight visitors and energise the city throughout February. Leading the festivities is the **Parade for Celebration of the Year of the Horse** (Feb 19th and 28th), promising a carnival atmosphere across key districts. The **2026 Chinese New Year Drones and Fireworks Displays** (Feb 19th, 23rd and Mar 3rd) are sure to fill the skyline with awesome spectacle, while the **Community Roadshow** (Feb 17th-18th) brings the seasonal spirit directly to local neighbourhoods. The much-anticipated **Chinese New Year Market 2026** (Feb 10th-17th) offers a showcase of traditional goods, decorations and festive treats. Beyond the Lunar New Year traditions, Macao's cultural calendar is as packed as ever. **Operation Oops! A Musical** (until Feb 2nd) delivers light-hearted entertainment, while pop fans can look forward to major live performances, including **WESTLIFE: A GALA EVENING IN MACAO** (Feb 7th) and **Silence Wang 2026 "Rise of Romance" World Tour – Macau** (Feb 27th – Mar 1st). With festivities abounding on its streets, in its skies, and on performance stages, February in Macao means the best-possible introduction to the Year of the Horse!

Activity of selling incense and pinwheels during Chinese New Year 2026

Pinwheels are traditionally used at Lunar New Year to ward off ill fortune and invite **good luck**. **Making offerings** and **uttering prayers** for the year ahead also play a central role in the festivities. During the holiday period, Barra Square hosts a cluster of stalls selling incense joss sticks and brightly-coloured pinwheels, providing worshippers with convenient access to essential ritual items while adding to the area's **seasonal atmosphere**.

This local version of a global annual religious celebration can be traced back to at least the 18th century. A statue of Christ carrying the Cross is conveyed in a solemn

procession from **St. Augustine's Church** to the city's **Cathedral**, for an overnight vigil. The following day, it is returned to St. Augustine's Church, making stops at symbolic **Stations of the Cross** around the city. On both days, the procession is flanked through the narrow streets by guardians in magenta robes, while the faithful and the curious watch.
