Spring is blooming, with food, sport and culture, all on the menu



March is living up to its promise, as it balances international showcase events with deeply rooted customs, offering a programme that reflects both global reach and cultural depth. A major highlight is **2026 International Cities of Gastronomy Fest, Macao** (Mar 20th-29th), reinforcing the city's role as a City of Gastronomy. The seasonal delights continue with the **2026 Macao International Parade** (Mar 29th), an international celebration of dance and multicultural performance. Sporting action keeps the city's energy levels high throughout the month. The **2026 Sands China Macao International 10K** (Mar 15th) offers runners a spectacular cityscape setting in return for their sweat and hard work, while **2026 FISE: Battle of the Champions • Macau** (Mar 13th-15th) returns with high-adrenaline urban sports featuring elite skateboarders. Rounding off the month, the **ITTF Men's and Women's World Cup Macao 2026** (Mar 30th - Apr 5th) brings the world's top table tennis players together for a showdown in Macao. Cultural traditions also take centre stage. Macao marks the traditional festival the **Birth of Tou Tei** (Mar 20th) with activities rooted in local customs. Earlier in the month, the **Holi Festival 2026@Macao** (Mar 8th), blends colour, music and Indian traditions. March in Macao delivers a dynamic mix of experiences signalling the city's full-tilt start to the spring season!

2026 International Cities of Gastronomy Fest, Macao



This gastronomy celebration marks a continuing strengthening of ties between Macao and fellow **UNESCO Creative Cities of Gastronomy**. The ingredients for this year's programme blend tourism promotion, culture and heritage with the star of the show, cuisine. Highlights include the **International Gastronomy Promenade** and the **City of Gastronomy Showcase**, alongside the **International Gastronomy Forum, Macao**. New elements to the programme add further flavour, including the **World Wines Lounge** event and the **Global Goodies Market**, showcasing premium gastronomic products from around the world.

Reflections of Maritime Connections: 16th-19th Century Sino-Portuguese Cultural Exchange



Between the 16th and 19th centuries, **China** established strong **trade** and **cultural connections** with various **Asian** and **European countries**, via the Maritime Silk Road. **Macao** held particular significance during this period as a vital transit hub linking China with Europe, and in particular with **Portugal**. This exhibition highlights **Sino-Portuguese cultural exchanges** from that era. It features approximately **177 items**, sourced from the **Palace Museum** in Beijing, from several **Portuguese cultural institutions** – including the National Museum of Ancient Art, Museu do Oriente, and the Ajuda Library – and from entities under Macao’s **Cultural Affairs Bureau**.
