From cultural celebrations to comedy performances and top-tier sports, the city is a non-stop showcase of events



April sees Macao's happenings pick up pace outdoors as well as indoors, proving why the city has the well-earned title of "City of Events".

Macao is an established favourite for tourists, and those planning additional getaways elsewhere shouldn't miss the **14<sup>th</sup> Macao International Travel (Industry) Expo (MITE)** (Apr 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>). It offers the latest trends in world travel and hot deals, while serving as a key platform for travel industry professionals to connect and explore new opportunities.

Culture and tradition are ever-present in Macao and April has plenty of both. The **Feast of Pak Tai** (Apr 18<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>) honours the god of the north, while the **28<sup>th</sup> Association of Macau Myanmar Overseas Chinese Water Festival** (Apr 18<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>) welcomes the Myanmar New Year. ### Feast of Pak Tai



The former fishing community in Taipa revered the Taoist god of the north, **Pak Tai**, and dedicated a temple to the deity over a century ago, a structure that still stands. The day celebrated as Pak Tai's birthday is the third day of the third month of the Chinese lunar calendar, this year falling on Apr 19<sup>th</sup>. The festivities include **Cantonese Opera performances** in tribute to the deity. The Pak Tai Celebrations were inscribed in 2020 in **Macao's Inventory of Intangible Cultural Heritage**.

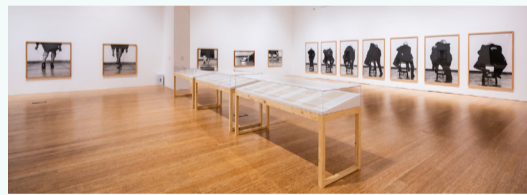

This is the first large-scale retrospective in Asia to focus on Portuguese contemporary artist **Helena Almeida** (1934–2018). The **“Presence”** section highlights **key moments** in her career. The works on display include early exploratory paintings, photographic series, sketches and videos, offering an overview of her artistic practice centred on representation of self. For the **“Resonance”** section, six female artists – Macao’s **Pang Yun, Wong Weng lo**, and **Angel Chan On Kei**, alongside Mainland China’s **Min Han, Gao Fuyan**, and **Sun Xiaoyu** – were invited to engage with Almeida’s body of work through newly-commissioned compositions.

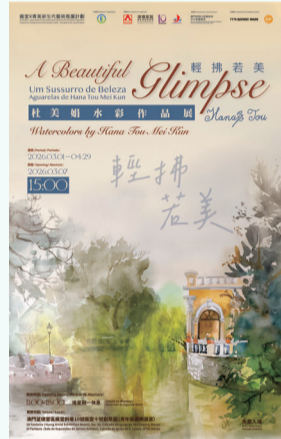

# Coming in May...

From long-standing rituals to contemporary music and craft, May is a great reminder that Macao is a city where heritage and modern creativity are in perfect harmony!
