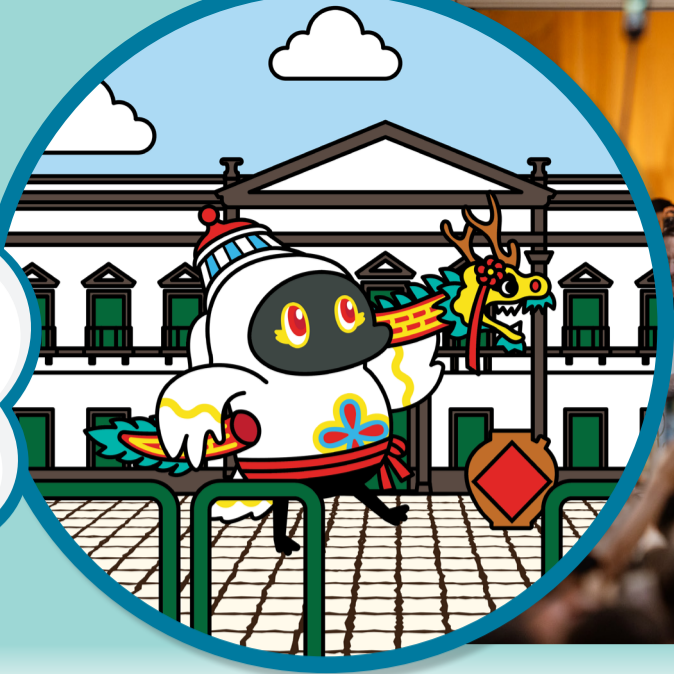

MAY, THE MACAO WAY

Feasts, festivals and flowing brews all feature in this month's offerings



May in Macao sees a fusion of traditions, rich flavours and top entertainment, all brewed together in a high-energy mix. Among the highlights are the **A-Ma Festival** (May 7th-11th), the **Feast of the Drunken Dragon** (May 24th) and the **Tam Kong Festival** (May 22nd-26th), where community-led parades and celebrations give centuries-old customs their 21st-century expression.

The **Procession of Our Lady of Fátima** (May 13th) offers more contemplative scenes, as worshippers move through the streets in prayer for one of the year's most important Catholic observances in the city.

Art takes centre stage at the **36th Macao Arts Festival** (May 8th - Jun 27th), where this year's theme, "New Streams of Inspiration", sets the tone for a rich programme that brings together an eclectic mix of local and international talent. Sport is set to make headlines with **UFC Fight Night Macau and Road to UFC** (May 28th-30th) marking a return to the city for a world-class showcase of mixed martial arts action.

Before that come more gentle treats, with the **Tap Siac Craft Market** (until May 3rd) gathering creative talent from across Macao and neighbouring regions, offering an array of distinctive handmade items. The easy-paced **Barra Slow Festival – A Sip of Tea, A Glimpse of Heritage** (May 1st-3rd) and the **Enjoy Macao with Coffee – Macao Coffee Festival** (until Jun 1st) invite visitors to savour carefully-crafted beverages in atmospheric surroundings.

May in Macao guarantees three things: bigger celebrations, bolder flavours, and greater excitement!

Pedestrian Zones during Labour Day Holidays

During the period of the Labour Day holidays, **Rua de Nossa Senhora do Amparo** on Macao peninsula, and **selected streets in Taipa Village**, turn vehicle-free, to ensure the safest and most comfortable setting for pedestrians. It means visitors and residents alike can stroll freely, discovering lesser-known corners of each area, and enjoying easy access to a rich mix of **dining, shopping, and cultural experiences**. Adding convenience, the newly launched **Tourism and "Leisure" Buses** initiative provides free shuttle bus services linking a number of hotels to local attractions, including the holiday-period pedestrian zone on Macao peninsula.

MAY 28TH-30TH

UFC Fight Night Macau and Road to UFC

The **Ultimate Fighting Championship (UFC)** franchise for **mixed martial arts (MMA)** returns to Macao with back-to-back newcomer tournament events leading up to a **UFC Fight Night** on May 30th. The big show is headlined by a pairing of elite bantamweights – China's No. 5-ranked **Song Yadong** and former two-time UFC champion **Deiveson Figueiredo** of Brazil. Ahead of it are two **Road to UFC** events on May 28th and 29th, featuring the opening phases of a **win-and-advance tournament**. The supporting events see 32 top MMA prospects from across the Asia-Pacific region begin their journey towards a UFC contract.

A-Ma Festival

This festival pays homage to one of the city's **best-known Chinese deities**, A-Ma, the Goddess of Seafarers. It coincides with the 23rd day of the third month of the Chinese lunar calendar – falling on May 9th this year – and celebrated as **A-Ma's birthday**. The festival's organiser, the Chinese Opera Association of Terrestrial and Maritime Dwellers of Barra, Macau, has been designated by the Ministry of Culture and Tourism of the People's Republic of China as the official guardian of the beliefs and customs surrounding A-Ma in Macao. Festival highlights include a series of **Cantonese opera performances**.

Feast of the Drunken Dragon



The Feast of the Drunken Dragon is a **unique folk festival** celebrated by Macao's fishmonger community. The event is on **China's National List of Intangible Cultural Heritage Representative Items**. It takes place annually on the eighth day of the Chinese lunar calendar's fourth month (this year on May 24th). Highlight of the celebrations is the Drunken Dragon and Lion Dance Parade, commencing at Senado Square. It then proceeds through several locations. **The Drunken Dragon dance** is traditionally performed by men who dance while simultaneously **spraying rice wine** from their mouths and **carrying effigies of dragons** carved head to tail from wood.

Tam Kong Festival

The sea deity Tam Kong is revered in **Taoism**, particularly among fishermen in southern China, including Macao. **Tam Kong Temple in Coloane** is the sole local site specially dedicated to such veneration. The annual Tam Kong Festival – included in Macao’s official **Inventory of Intangible Cultural Heritage** since 2020 – is observed on the eighth day of the Chinese lunar calendar’s fourth month (this year on May 24th). A temporary stage made of bamboo is commonly erected to host Cantonese opera performances.

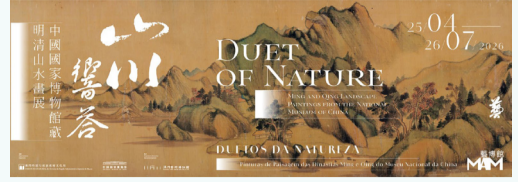
