MACAO'S THE NAME FOR SUMMER MAGIC

The city itself takes the July headlines in the arts, sport and culture

From packed arenas to centuries-old festivities, July in Macao means a city in full flow – energetic, varied and always offering new ways to experience its delights! The **3rd Macao International Children's Arts Festival** (until Aug 30th) continues a tradition of colourful creativity via a wide range of performances, workshops and exhibitions to engage participants of all ages. Meanwhile, the **International Youth Dance Festival 2026** (Jul 18th-23rd) draws young performers from near and far, presenting a rich variety of dance styles and forms of cultural expression. The **Women's Volleyball Nations League – Finals Macao 2026 presented by Galaxy Entertainment Group** (Jul 22nd-23rd and 25th-26th) is where top national teams – including China's – compete for glory at the Macao East Asian Games Dome. Events embedded in local tradition also feature in the month's line-up. The **Feast of Na Tcha** (Jul 2nd) and the **Celebrations of Lou Pan** (Jul 26th) highlight enduring elements of Chinese heritage, while the **Procession of Saint Roque** (Jul 12th) reflects the city's distinctive East-meets-West cultural identity. Macao's midsummer mix ensures the city is a cool place to be, even on the hottest days!

UNTIL JUL 2ND

Feast of Na Tcha

The beliefs and customs associated with the deity **Na Tcha** (also known as “Nezha”) are one of Macao's most distinctive traditions, being on **China's National List of Intangible Cultural Heritage Representative Items** and **Macao's Inventory of Intangible Cultural Heritage**. The Feast of Na Tcha, observed on the 18th day of the Chinese lunar calendar's fifth month (this year on July 2nd) features **rituals** and **folk practices** dedicated to this **deity of children**. A focal point of activities for the Feast of Na Tcha is **Na Tcha Temple near the Ruins of St. Paul's**: associated events include a parade on Macao peninsula and in Taipa. Another celebration of the festival period is the Prince Na Tcha Parade, featuring a “dragon guard” and “celestial beauties” scattering petals in abundance. It starts from the **Na Tcha Ancient Temple**, on Calçada das Verdades, before heading to nearby Senado Square.

The Procession of Saint Roque is an annual **Catholic act of homage**, included in the city's **Inventory of Intangible Cultural Heritage**. The procession

takes place on the second Sunday of July every year, in honour of **Saint Roque**, for his intercession with the divinity to suppress a plague outbreak in Macao at the end of the 19th century. It starts from **St. Lazarus Church**, passes through the neighbouring streets, before heading back to the church.

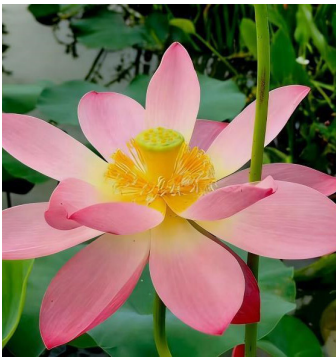

Closing Concert “Chopin by Zitong Wang”**

For its final concert of the current season, the **Macao Orchestra** has invited pianist **Zitong Wang** from Mainland China to perform in a tribute to Polish-French composer and pianist **Frédéric Chopin** (1810–1849), featuring the latter’s “**Piano Concerto No. 1**”. Ms Wang was awarded the Bronze Medal at the 19th International Chopin Piano Competition held last year, and also received the contest’s Krystian Zimerman Award for Best Sonata Performance. 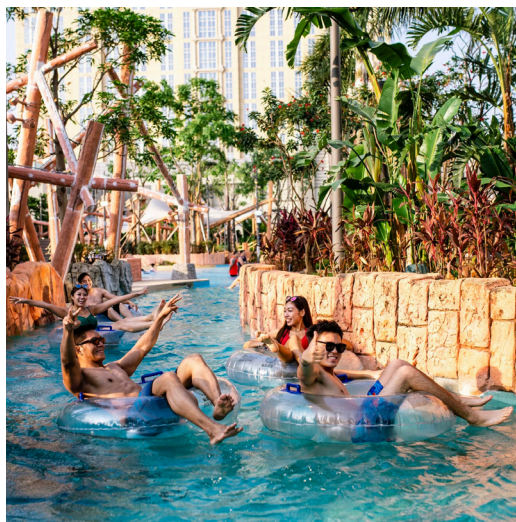
