The Feast of Kuan Tai, or the **Kuan Tai Celebrations**, is an annual event on the 24th day of the sixth month of the Chinese lunar calendar, which falls on August 6th this year. Visiting During Typhoon Season

The period from May to November is typhoon season in Macao. The city has five levels of tropical cyclone warning. They range from 1 (the lowest and least intense) through 3, 8, and 9, up to 10 (the highest and most dangerous). When a cyclone signal of 8 or above is issued, public buses (including the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge shuttle bus service) and the light rapid transit system are suspended. 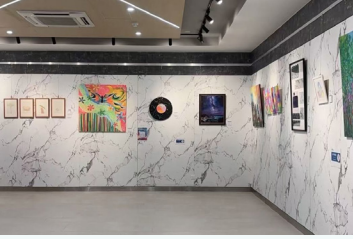

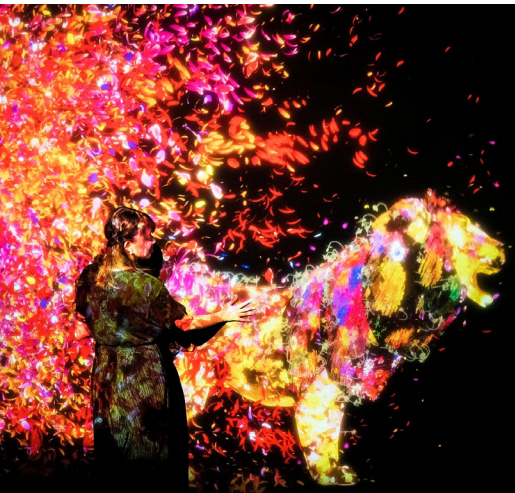
