September offers plenty of reasons to explore Macao

It's the start of one of Macao's busiest seasons events-wise, with major sporting competitions, yearly gatherings, and evening spectacles drawing visitors into the city.

The **34th Macao International Fireworks Display Contest** (Sep 12th, 19th, 25th and Oct 1st, 4th) once again illuminates the city's skyline. The **2026 World Tourism Day Tray Race** (Sep 27th) adds some street-level skills to the programme, as contestants race through some of Macao's best-known thoroughfares while balancing trays. Meanwhile, **The 5th China (Macao) High-quality Consumption Exhibition & Hengqin Global Bay Areas Forum** (Sep 11th-13th) focuses on premium consumer goods, lifestyle products and services. Sport takes the spotlight with **WTT Champions Macao 2026 presented by Galaxy Entertainment Group** (Sep 8th-13th). The tournament brings together many of the world's leading table tennis players for six days of top-level competition. As summer gives way to autumn, Macao's events schedule stays as hot as ever for September!

34th Macao International Fireworks Display Contest



The latest edition of the annual Macao International Fireworks Display Contest brings together **high-profile pyrotechnics experts** from around the world to light up Macao's night sky with stunning displays. Mission control is the **waterfront near Macau Tower**, and each display is accompanied by **music**, for a multisensory experience. Spectators can watch from the waterside near Macau Tower or from other **prime viewing points**. They include: Anim'Arte NAM VAN by the lakeside at Nam Van; the area along Avenida de Sagres next to the Mandarin Oriental, Macau; Caminho Marginal do Lago, next to YOHO Treasure Island Hotel; the area between the Kun lam Ecumenical Centre and the Leisure Area of the Kun lam Statue Waterfront; the Macao Science Center Promenade; and the shoreline in Taipa. This year's opening and closing nights will also feature **drone performances**, adding another layer to the spectacle in the sky.

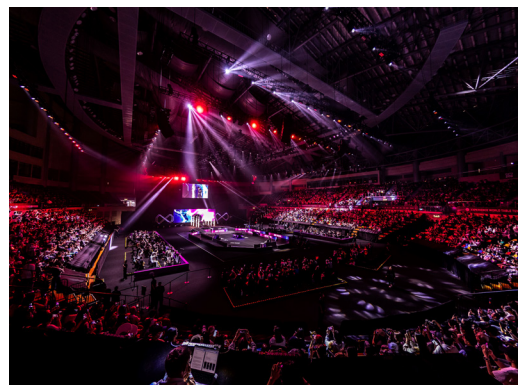

They range from 1 (the lowest and least intense) through 3, 8, and 9, up to 10 (the highest and most dangerous). When a cyclone signal of 8 or above is issued, public buses (including the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge shuttle bus service) and the light rapid transit system are suspended. 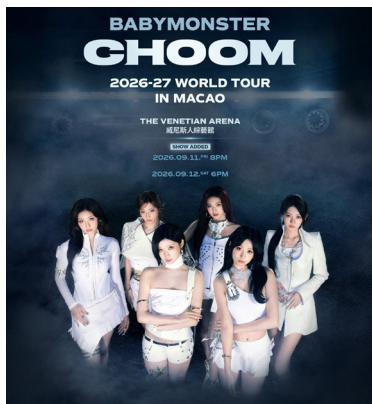
